NEW FOR 2012

There will be a Goodie Bag from Walk to Canter Equestrian Supplies to be given to the horse/rider combination with the highest percentage score of the day.

All Horses and Ponies that gain a position 1 to 6 will qualify for the Masters Dressage Championship with the opportunity to win a voucher from Walk to Canter Equestrian Supplies up to the value of £100.00. This will be awarded to the horse rider combination with the highest percentage score on the day at the Masters Championship to be held in September.

Hickstead 15+ Dressage Championship & 15+ Horse & Pony National Championships at Equifest 2012

To qualify for the 15+ Dressage Championship at the Hickstead Unaffiliated Dressage Championship, competitors must have won 15 pts or more at each level for a place. Points will be awarded to the first 10 places to competitors with equines aged 15 years & over in all tests. Ten points to 1st place, nine points to 2nd place to one point for 10th place. Intro tests do not apply.

The highest placed three horses and ponies in each class that are 15 years old or more will qualify for the National 15+ Horse & Pony Event Championships at Equifest 2012

Royal London Show Qualifiers

BRC Rosettes

Rosettes and points will be awarded from 1st to 10th towards this years' Trophies to be presented to the Senior and Junior with the most points gained throughout the season in October 2012.

Rules

Warm up on grass outdoors. Tests may be read. Lead reins allowed.

Juniors are 16 years and under on 1st January 2012

This show will be run under a combination of British Dressage and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

It is essential that you clear up the mess around your transport please. No horse droppings or hay to be left on the ground. We will be charged if you do not clear up after you.

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Please take all your horses' droppings home with you. The club will be fined for any mess we leave behind.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. The judges discretion at all times will be the rule of the day.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. Where riding through any area other than above it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

Entries may be sent by post enclosing a cheque. Email entries will be accepted with payment by bank transfer. Refunds will be made if we are informed by midnight the day before but a £3 administration fee will be retained. If BRC are forced to cancel the event, refunds will be made in full.

Deadlines

Entries close Monday prior to the show date. Strictly no late entries.
