All Eventer trial classes will be in 60 x 40 arena

CLASS ONE: Very Novice: horse or pony not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any cross-country event. Riders any age. Jumps approx 2'

CLASS TWO: Novice Horse or pony. Riders any age. Jumps approx 2'6"

CLASS THREE: Intermediate Horse or pony. Riders any age. Jumps approx 2'9"

CLASS FOUR: Open Horse or pony. Riders any age. Jumps approx 3'

All Dressage Classes will be in 20 x 40 arena

CLASS FIVE: Dressage – Intro B

CLASS SIX: Dressage Prelim 10

CLASS SEVEN: Novice 28

Eventer trial rules

Jumping classes will be run in order. Show jumps (coloured fences) will be jumped first under BSJA rules. The competitor on completing the show jumping course will go straight on to the cross-country fences, which will be rustic and built as closely as possible to cross country fences. This phase will be judged under British Eventing Rules.

Penalties from both phases will be added together and the competitor with the least number of penalties will be the winner. Should there be equality of penalties then time will decide the winner.

Cross Country penalties will be:

Knockdown	- 5 penalties
1 st Disobedience	- 10 penalties
2 nd Disobedience	- 20 penalties
3 rd Disobedience	- 30 penalties and move to next fence
Fall of horse or rider	- elimination – to leave the arena on foot
Error of course corrected	- 30 penalties
Error of course not corrected	- elimination

Rosettes and Trophies

Rosettes to at least tenth place

Points will be awarded from 1st to 10th towards the Membership Trophies to be presented to the Senior and Junior Members with the most points gained throughout the season in October

Rules

Juniors are 16 years and under on the day of the show.

This show will be run under a combination of British Dressage, British Eventing, British Show jumping and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by either the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. The judges discretion at all times will be the rule of the day.

Please take your litter home with you and do not muck out your trailers and boxes on the ground. If possible, please clean the area where you have parked before you go and take your horse droppings from around your box home with you.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. Where riding through any area other than above it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

Entries may be sent by post enclosing a cheque. Email entries will be accepted with payment IN CASH ONLY on the day. Entries made by email and then not showing will be banned from making entries this way in any future event.

Deadlines

Entries close Wednesday 24 March 2010. Strictly no late entries for dressage. Late entries for the Eventer trial if room £2.00 extra per class
