Open to all novice riders, horses and ponies

CLASS ONE: Very Novice: horse or pony not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any cross-country event. Riders any age. Dressage test Intro B (walk and trot) All jumps approx 2'. Class may be divided into ponies and horses if entries warrant

CLASS ONE A: Individual Dressage – Intro Test B – the test will be ridden once and the highest scoring competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS ONE B: Individual Show Jumping – the section will be ridden once and the competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS ONE C: Individual Cross Country – the section will be ridden once and the competitors with the least penalties results will count for the class placing

CLASS TWO: Novice Horse or pony. Riders any age. Dressage test Prelim 4. All jumps approx 2' 6". Class may be divided into ponies and horses if entries warrant

CLASS TWO A: Individual Dressage – Prelim 4 – the test will be ridden once and the highest scoring competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS TWO B: Individual Show Jumping – the section will be ridden once and the competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS TWO C: Individual Cross Country – the section will be ridden once and the competitors with the least penalties results will count for the class placing

CLASS THREE: Intermediate Horse or pony. Riders any age. Dressage test Prelim 4. All jumps approx 2' 9". Class may be divided into ponies and horses if entries warrant

CLASS THREE A: Individual Dressage – Prelim 7 - the test will be ridden once and the highest scoring competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS THREE B: Individual Show Jumping – the section will be ridden once and the competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS THREE C: Individual Cross Country – the section will be ridden once and the competitors with the least penalties results will count for the class placing

CLASS FOUR: Open Horse or pony. Riders any age. Dressage test Novice 28. All Jumps approx 3'. Class may be divided into ponies and horses if entries warrant

CLASS FOUR A: Individual Dressage – Prelim 7 - the test will be ridden once and the highest scoring competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS FOUR B: Individual Show Jumping – the section will be ridden once and the competitors results will count for the class placing

CLASS FOUR C: Individual Cross Country – the section will be ridden once and the competitors with the least penalties results will count for the class placing

Rules

Juniors are 16 years and under on the day of the show.

This show will be run under a combination of British Dressage and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by either the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. The judges discretion at all times will be the rule of the day.

Please take your litter home with you and do not muck out your trailers and boxes on the ground. If possible, please clean the area where you have parked before you go and take your horse droppings from around your box home with you.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. Where riding through any area other than above it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

Entries may be sent by post enclosing a cheque. Email entries will be accepted with payment IN CASH ONLY on the day. Entries made by email and then not showing will be banned from making entries this way in any future event.

Deadlines

Entries close Wednesday 31 March 2010. Strictly no late entries.
