Classes

RING ONE - IN HAND SHOWING - 9.30

CLASS 1: Best Condition – any height

CLASS 2: Cobs or Cob Types in hand – any height (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 3: Mountain and Moorland Large and Small Breeds. Colts over three years must be bitted. Excluding Welsh breeds. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 3A: Welsh A/B/C/D, any age. Colts over three years must be bitted. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 4: One, Two and Three year olds, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split.

CLASS 5: Coloureds – any age, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 5 A: Paints and Spots– any age, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split.

CLASS 6: Bays browns Blacks etc - any age, any height. Colts over three years be bitted
Class may be split.

CLASS 7: Greys Roans, Palomino etc. any age, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split.

Class 8: In hand veteran 15 years and over

RING TWO - RIDDEN SHOWING - 9.30

CLASS 9: Family Pony – 14.2 and under. May be required to jump a small fence

CLASS 10: Pony Club/Riding Club Horse– any age any height. May be required to jump a small fence (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 11: Working Hunter Type Pony – 14.2 and under – will be required to jump

CLASS 12: Working Hunter Type – over 14.2 – will be required to jump

CLASS 13: Ridden Cob or Cob Type – any height (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 14: Ridden Veteran – any height, 15 years and over

CLASS 15: Working Cob or Cob Type, any height. Will be required to jump

CLASS 16: Mountain and Moorland Large and Small Breeds. Excluding Welsh breeds. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

CLASS 17: Welsh A/B/C/D, any age. Colts over three years must be bitted. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see Rules for details)

RING THREE - SHOW JUMPING - 10.00

CLASS 18: Really Novice jumping – lead reins accepted and assistance allowed. Straight poles – bottom holes!

CLASS 19: Novice Jumping – cross poles and straight poles approx 1'6

CLASS 20: intermediate Novice Jumping approx 2'

CLASS 21: open Novice Jumping approx 2'6

CLASS 22: Novice pairs relay – approx 2' – Fun class enter on the day - £6.00 per pair. Results do not count towards yearly points.

RING FOUR - CLEAR ROUND JUMPING - 10.00

Clear round jumping will take place all day. Fences will be suitable to be a warm up for the next class in the jumping ring.

Entries on the day – tickets from show secretary - £2.50 per round or three rounds £6.00.

Rules

15+ Horse & Pony Events

To qualify for the Championship Show the first, second and third place horse/pony in the following classes will each receive a Qualification Card. To enter this Championship Show the rider/handler and horse/pony must register with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 21 days of the qualifying show date.

All Horses/Ponies wishing to qualify for the 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced classes must wear white arm bands.

Home Produced Classes

1. No Horse/Pony must have been in a professional yard & must be shown by the Exhibitor not involved in professional producing within the last 3 years.
2. Owners, Exhibitors and Handlers must not produce any horse/pony other than their own for financial gain.
3. Exhibitors and handlers must not exhibit under any Judge that has kept any horses/ponies at livery/stud with them or has had any horse/ponies leased, loaned, or produced by the Judge within the last two years.

Juniors are 16 years and under on the day of the show.

This show will be run under a combination of British Show Jumping and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by either the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. The judges discretion at all times will be the rule of the day.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. Where riding through any area other than above it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

Entries may be sent by post enclosing a cheque. Email entries will be accepted with payment IN CASH ONLY on the day. Entries made by email and then not showing will be banned from making entries this way in any future event.

All 3 year old colts must be bitted and stallions shown in bridles.

Rosettes and Trophies

Rosettes to at least eighth place

Points will be awarded from 1st to 8th towards the Membership Trophies to be presented to the Senior and Junior Members with the most points gained throughout the season in October
