### **RING ONE - Ridden Showing (on grass surface)**

Judges: Mrs J Hunt & tbc

**CLASS 1:** Tack & Turnout – any height ridden

**CLASS 2:** Lead Rein – 14.2 and under - Amateur Showing Society Qualifier

**CLASS 3:** Part Bred Mountain and Moorland –any height. Class may be split if entries warrant (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 4:** Pony Club Pony – 14.2 and under (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 5:** Riding Horse – over 14.2 (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 6:** Family Pony – 14.2 and under. May be required to jump a small fence

**CLASS 7:** Family Horse – over 14.2. May be required to jump a small fence

**CLASS 8:** Working Hunter Type Pony – 14.2 and under. May be required to jump a small fence

**CLASS 9:** Working Hunter Type – over 14.2. May be required to jump a small fence

**CLASS 10:** Ridden Cob or Cob Type – any height, may be plaited (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 11:** working Cob or Cob Type – any height, may be plaited, and may be required to jump a small fence

**CLASS 12:** Ridden Veteran – any height, 15 years and over, Class to be split 15 - 20 and 21 and over if sufficient entries. Entry fees from this class will be donated World Horse Welfare, who kindly donated rosettes. Amateur Showing Society Qualifier

**RING ONE CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> prizewinners from each class qualify

Champion and Reserve to go forward to Supreme Championship to be held in ring 4 once all showing classes have finished.

### **RING TWO - 10.30 start - In Hand Showing (on grass surface)**

Judge: Mrs P Porter & tbc

**CLASS 13:** Best condition – any age, any height, in hand

**CLASS 14:** Cobs or Cob Types any age any height (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 15:** Paints, Spots and Coloureds – any age, any height. Class may be split if entries warrant. Colts three years old and over must be bitted (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 16:** Part Bred Mountain and Moorland – any age, any height. Class may be split if entries warrant. Colts three years old and over must be bitted (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 17:** Bay, Browns, Blacks etc. – any age, any height. Class may be split if entries warrant. Colts three years old and over must be bitted.

**CLASS 18:** Greys, Roans and Palominos etc. – any age, any height. Class may be split if entries warrant. Colts three years old and over must be bitted.

**CLASS 19:** Mountain and Moorland – any age, any height. Class may be split if entries warrant. Colts three years old and over must be bitted

**CLASS 20:** One, Two and Three year olds, any breed, any size at maturity. Class will be split if entries warrant under 14.2 and over 14.2

**CLASS 21:** Arabs – Pure, Anglo and Part-Breds any age (qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Home Produced – see rules for details).

**CLASS 22:** Child handler under 12 years old – will be judged on ability to walk out, trot up and stand up to present to judge

**RING TWO CHAMPIONSHIP** – 1<sup>st</sup> Prize winners from each class qualify.

### **RING THREE - Show Jumping (on grass surface)**

**CLASS 23:** Very Novice – suitable for lead reins, horses and ponies any height; very small fences

**CLASS 24:** Novice – horses and ponies any height; jumps not to exceed 1'6" first round

**CLASS 25:** Intermediate – horses and ponies any height; jumps not to exceed 1'9" first round

**CLASS 26:** Small Open - horses and ponies any height; jumps not to exceed round 2' first round

**CLASS 27:** Open - horses and ponies any height; jumps not to exceed 2'3" first round

**CLASS 28:** Large Open - horses and ponies any height; jumps not to exceed 2'6" first round

### Rules

Juniors are 16 years and under on the day of the show.

This show will be run under a combination of British Show Jumping and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by either the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. The judges discretion at all times will be the rule of the day.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. When riding through any area other than above, it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

All 3 year old colts must be bitted and stallions shown in bridles.

### Rosettes and Trophies

Rosettes to at least tenth place

Trophies or prizes to all winners

Points will be awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> towards the Membership Trophies to be presented to the Senior and Junior Members with the most points gained throughout the season in October

### 15+ Horse & Pony Events

To qualify for the Championship Show the first, second and third place horse/pony in the classes indicated in the schedule will each receive a Qualification Card. To enter this Championship Show the rider/handler and horse/pony must register with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 21 days of the qualifying show date.

#### Home Produced Classes

1. No Horse/Pony must have been in a professional yard & must be shown by the Exhibitor not be involved in professional producing within the last 3 years.

2. Owners, Exhibitors and Handlers must not produce any horse/pony other than their own for financial gain
3. Exhibitors and handlers must not exhibit under any Judge that has kept any horses/ponies at livery/stud with them or has had any horse/ponies leased, loaned, or produced by the Judge within the last two years.
