**Class 1** – Young stock – One, two and Three year olds, fillies, geldings or colts (3yr old colts must be bitted). Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 2** - Large Mountain & Moorland Pure and Part Bred. Any age. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 3** – Small Mountain & Moorland Pure and Part Bred. Any age. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 4** – In Hand Hunter Horse/Pony Type– any age. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 5** – In Hand Cob/ Cob Type – any age. Class will be split if entries warrant.

### **RING 2 – RIDDEN – Outdoors on a surface – not before 12.00**

**Class 7** – Best condition and turnout - Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 8** – Best lead rein

**Class 9** – Best first pony 14.2 and under Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 10** – Best novice riding pony/horse – not to have won 2 firsts in a riding pony/horse class. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 11** - Large Mountain & Moorland Pure and Part Bred. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 12** – Small Mountain & Moorland Pure and Part Bred. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 13** – Ridden Hunter Horse/Pony Type. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 14** – Ridden Cob/ Cob Type. Class will be split if entries warrant.

**Class 15** – Ridden veteran – 15 years or older. Class will be split if entries warrant.

### **RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP – FIRST PLACINGS FROM CLASSES 7 TO 15**

**PLEASE NOTE:** Warm up for ring one will be the outdoor school and warm up for the ridden classes will be in the indoor school. Please vacate the warm up areas promptly if asked to do so.

## Rosettes

Rosettes to at least TENTH place.

There will be a special rosette from the 15+ Horse & Pony Events to the highest placed horse or pony 15 years old or older in all classes except classes 1, 2 and 6.

Points will be awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> towards the Membership Trophies to be presented to the Senior and Junior Members with the most points gained throughout the season in October

## Masters Championships

You must be a member of Braintree Riding Club to qualify for this show. Any place gained 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> will qualify for the Championships. You must get your membership card signed by the judge on the day of the show at which you qualified. This cannot be done at a later date!

### Rules

Juniors are under 16 years on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012.

This show will be run under a combination of British Show Jumping and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by either the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. Where riding through any area other than above it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

Entries may be sent by post enclosing a cheque. Email entries will be accepted with payment by bank transfer (details on entry form). No entries will be accepted without payment.

### Deadlines

Entries close on the Monday prior to the show (19 March 2012)

Late entries on the day - if classes not full - at £2.00 extra
