#### RING ONE - IN HAND SHOWING - 9.00

**CLASS 1:** Best Condition – any height – any age

**CLASS 2:** One, Two and Three year olds, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split.

**CLASS 3:** Coloureds – any age, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split.

**CLASS 4:** Paints and Spots – any age, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split

**CLASS 5:** Bays, Browns Blacks etc - any age, any height. Colts over three years be bitted. Class may be split.

**CLASS 6:** Greys, Roans, Palomino etc. any age, any height. Colts over three years must be bitted. Class may be split.

**CLASS 7:** TBs and Ex racehorses – must be Weatherbys Registered - any age any, height, please have passports available. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15years or more will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

**CLASS 8:** Cobs or Cob Types in hand – any height (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15+ will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

**CLASS 9:** Mountain and Moorland Large and Small Breeds. Colts over three years must be bitted. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15+ will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

**CLASS 10:** Part Bred Mountain & Moorland Large and Small breeds. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15+ will qualify - please wear armbands to be eligible).

**Class 11:** In hand veteran 15 years and over

### RING TWO - RIDDEN SHOWING - 10.00

**CLASS 12:** Lead rein 13.2 and under rider 12 years & under 4 years old or over (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony National Championships at Equifest – highest three ponies 15 years and over will qualify - please wear armbands to be eligible)

**CLASS13:** First ridden 13.2 and under rider 12 years & under 4 years old or over. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15years and over will qualify - please wear armbands to be eligible)

**CLASS 14:** Novice First Ridden Pony – not have won two firsts in any ridden pony class. 4 years old or over. No cantering as a ride in this class.

**CLASS 15:** Family Pony – 14.2 and under. May be required to jump a small fence

**CLASS 16:** Pony Club/Riding Club Horse – 4 years old or over, any height. May be required to jump a small fence (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15years or over will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

## Schedule

**CLASS 17:** Working Hunter Type Pony – 14.2 and under – will be required to jump

**CLASS 18:** Working Hunter Type – over 14.2 – will be required to jump

**CLASS 19:** Ridden Cob or Cob Type – any height 4 years old or over (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15 years or more will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

**CLASS 20:** Ridden Veteran – any height, 15 years and over

**CLASS 21:** Working Cob or Cob Type, any height. Will be required to jump

**CLASS 22:** Mountain and Moorland Large and Small Breeds 4 years old or over (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15 or more will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

**CLASS 23:** Mountain and Moorland part breeds 4 years old or over (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15 or more will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

**CLASS 24:** Competition Horse over 14.2 – 4 years old or over. Horses will not be required to jump. The class will be judged 50% on turnout and condition of the horse and rider, and 50% on the freestyle show, not exceeding 2 minutes. Show must include a halt, walk on a long rein and a Working trot and canter with a change of rein. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15 years or more will qualify - please wear armbands to be eligible)

**CLASS 25:** Competition Pony 14.2 and under – 4 years old or over Horses will not be required to jump. The class will be judged 50% on turnout and condition of the horse and rider, and 50% on the freestyle show, not exceeding 2 minutes. Show must include a halt, walk on a long rein and a Working trot and canter with a change of rein. (Qualifier for 15+ Horse & Pony Essex Championships and National Championships at Equifest – highest three horses/ponies 15 years or more will qualify - please wear arm bands to be eligible)

## Rules

### 15+ Horse & Pony Events

To qualify for the Championship Show the first, second and third place horse/pony in the classes marked as qualifiers will each receive a Qualification Card. To enter the Championship Shows the rider/handler and horse/pony must complete their registrations with 15+ Horse & Pony Events within 21 days of the qualifying show date.

Memberships will be available on the day but will require final verification with 15+ Horse & Pony Events. ## Schedule

Juniors are 16 years and under on the day of the show.

This show will be run under a combination of British Show Jumping and Braintree Riding Club rules but please note the following:

No responsibility can be accepted for any loss or damage to property or accident to horse, rider or spectator by either the landowners, their agents or any of the management committee.

Dogs must be on leads at all times.

Hard hats and suitable footwear must be worn at all times while mounted. The judges discretion at all times will be the rule of the day.

Absolutely no galloping or cantering allowed outside of the designated ring/practice areas. Where riding through any area other than above it must be done at walk. You may be asked to leave the show ground if this is not adhered to.

Any misuse of whips or spurs (both of which are discouraged at this show although they are allowed) will be met by a request that the competitor leaves the show ground.

Entries may be sent by post enclosing a cheque. Email entries will be accepted with payment IN CASH ONLY on the day. Entries made by email and then not showing will be banned from making entries this way in any future event.

All 3 year old colts must be bitted and stallions shown in bridles.

### Rosettes and Trophies

Rosettes to at least tenth place

Points will be awarded from 1<sup>st</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> towards the Membership Trophies to be presented to the Senior and Junior Members with the most points gained throughout the season in October

Members gaining 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place will qualify for the MASTERS Championship snow in September.
